Purpose

Unit of measure conversions allow the user to stock items in one unit of measure but purchase and/or sell those same items in a different unit of measure.

Overview

This procedure outlines the steps for identifying unit of measure conversions within the Pentagon 2000 system.

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
Procedure

1. Identifying a General Unit of Measure Factor:

Unit of measure conversions will be calculated based upon the factors identified within the unit of measure table unless a parts master record unit of measure conversion table with the proper unit of measure exists.


NOTE: General unit of measure conversions are contained within the unit of measure table.

- a. Left-click **Administration** from the toolbar.
- b. Go to Stock Tables List By Code.
- c. Left-click Unit Measure (UM).




d. The **UM List** search window will appear.

NOTE: The values shown in the table appearing in this procedure are not standard values and may not reflect the values required by every organization.





e. Left-click the record for which a factor must be identified or modified (the line will be highlighted in blue) and left-click the **Edit** button. The **Insert UM** window for the selected unit of measure will appear.



f. Left-click the cursor into the **Factor** field and type in the number that represents the appropriate factor.

EXAMPLE: If the unit of measure "EA" has a factor of 1 and the unit of measure "TF" has a factor of 35, then when conversion is made from 1 TF, it will equal 35 EA.

[1 (quantity) * 35 (factor for TF) / 1 (factor for EA) = 35 EA]

This conversion will be the same if converting to any other unit of measure with a factor of 1.

EXAMPLE: If the unit of measure "FY" has a factor of 50 and the unit of measure "HU" has a factor of 100, then when conversion is made from 3 HU, it will equal 6 FY.

[3 (quantity) * 100 (factor for HU) / 50 (factor for FY) = 6 FY]

g. Left-click the **OK** button at the top of the **Edit UM** window to save the factor and close the window.






2. Identifying a Part Master Record Unit of Measure Conversion:


a. From the main menu screen, left-click the **Inventory** button.



NOTE: Inventory may also be accessed from the toolbar. Left-click the **Inventory** item from the toolbar and then left-click **Parts List** from the menu options




b. The **Partnumber** search window will appear.




c. Navigate to the part master record that requires a unit of measure conversion identified. Select the appropriate record (left-click the record within the search window and left-click the **OK** button; or double-click the file within the explorer screen).




d. The **Partnumber** window for the selected part master record will appear.




- e. Left-click the **Opt** button from the toolbar on the **Partnumber** window.
- f. Left-click B. Qty UM Conversion.



g. The **Stock UM List** search window will appear.



h. Left-click the **Add** button. The **Insert Stock UM** window will appear.



- i. Identify the **From UM** for the conversion.
 - i. If the unit of measure exists in the **UM List**:


NOTE: To access this table, left-click **Administration** from the tool bar, go to **Stock Tables List by Code**, and left-click **Unit Measure (UM)**.

1. Left-click the ellipses in the **From UM** field.



2. The UM List search window will appear.

NOTE: The values shown in the table appearing in this procedure are not standard values and may not reflect the values required by every organization.



- 3. Select the appropriate unit of measure (left-click the line within the search screen and left-click **OK**; or double-click the line within the search screen).
- ii. If the unit of measure does not exist in the **UM List**:
 - 1. The unit of measure may be added to the **UM List**, or
 - 2. Left-click the cursor into the **From UM** field and type the appropriate unit of measure.
- j. Left-click the cursor into the **Factor** field and type in the number that represents the appropriate factor for the unit of measure selected identified in the **From UM** field.

NOTE: The unit of measure identified in the **Stock UM** on the **Stock tab** will always have a factor of 1 and will always be a part of the conversion formula.

EXAMPLE: The **Stock UM** is "EA" and the item may be purchased by the case. If the unit of measure "EA" has a factor of 1 and the unit of measure "CS" has a factor of 144, then when conversion is made from 3 CS, it will equal 432 EA.

The factor of 144 means there are 144 EA per 1 CS.

[3 (quantity) * 144 (factor for CS) / 1 (factor for EA) = 432 EA]



EXAMPLE: The Stock UM is "HU" and the item is purchased in pounds. If the unit of measure "HU" has a factor of 1 and the unit of measure "LB" has a factor of 0.3, then when conversion is made from 6 HU, it will equal 1.8 LB.

The factor of 0.3 means there are 0.3 LB per 1 HU.

[6 (quantity) * 0.3 (factor for HU) / 1 (factor for HU) = 1.8 LB]

k. Left-click the **OK** button at the top of the **Edit Stock UM** window to save the factor and close the window.



I. Left-click the **Close** button in the lower right of the **Stock UM List** window to close the window.






3. Editing a Part Master Record Unit of Measure Conversion:


a. From the main menu screen, left-click the **Inventory** button.



NOTE: Inventory may also be accessed from the toolbar. Left-click the **Inventory** item from the toolbar and then left-click **Parts List** from the menu options




b. The **Partnumber** search window will appear.




c. Navigate to the part master record that requires a unit of measure conversion modified. Select the appropriate record (left-click the record within the search window and left-click the **OK** button; or double-click the file within the explorer screen).



d. The **Partnumber** window for the selected part master record will appear.




- e. Left-click the **Opt** button from the toolbar on the **Partnumber** window.
- f. Left-click B. Qty UM Conversion.



g. The **Stock UM List** search window will appear.

NOTE: The values shown in the table appearing in this procedure are not standard values and may not reflect the values required by every organization.





h. Left-click the record for which a factor must be modified (the line will be highlighted in blue) and left-click the **Edit** button. The **Edit Stock UM** window for the selected unit of measure will appear.



i. Left-click the cursor into the **Factor** field and type in the number that represents the appropriate factor for the unit of measure selected identified in the **From UM** field.

NOTE: The unit of measure identified in the **Stock UM** on the **Stock tab** will always have a factor of 1 and will always be a part of the conversion formula.

EXAMPLE: The **Stock UM** is "EA" and the item may be purchased by the case. If the unit of measure "EA" has a factor of 1 and the unit of measure "CS" has a factor of 144, then when conversion is made from 3 CS, it will equal 432 EA.

The factor of 144 means there are 144 EA per 1 CS.

[3 (quantity) * 144 (factor for CS) / 1 (factor for EA) = 432 EA]

[6 (quantity) * 0.3 (factor for HU) / 1 (factor for HU) = 1.8 LB]

j. Left-click the **OK** button at the top of the **Edit Stock UM** window to save the factor and close the window.



k. Left-click the Close button in the lower right of the Stock UM List window to close the window.






4. Deleting a Part Master Record Unit of Measure Conversion:


a. From the main menu screen, left-click the **Inventory** button.



NOTE: Inventory may also be accessed from the toolbar. Left-click the **Inventory** item from the toolbar and then left-click **Parts List** from the menu options




b. The **Partnumber** search window will appear.




c. Navigate to the part master record that requires a unit of measure conversion deleted. Select the appropriate record (left-click the record within the search window and left-click the **OK** button; or double-click the file within the explorer screen).



d. The **Partnumber** window for the selected part master record will appear.




- e. Left-click the **Opt** button from the toolbar on the **Partnumber** window.
- f. Left-click B. Qty UM Conversion.




g. The **Stock UM List** search window will appear.

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- h. Left-click the record to be deleted (the line will be highlighted in blue) and left-click the **Delete** button.
- i. A **Confirm** window will appear.



- j. Left-click **Yes** to delete the record.
- k. Left-click the **Close** button in the lower right of the **Stock UM List** window to close the window.
